United Way in Ottawa County hosting Golf Experience this summer

PORT CLINTON, Ohio – This summer, the United Way in Ottawa County Golf Experience will give golfers a chance to tour four of the county’s fantastic golf courses — and an opportunity to play at the Catawba Island Club for free. The tour begins May 14 at the Oak Harbor Golf Club. The schedule of events is as follows:

- Oak Harbor Golf Club — Saturday, May 14, 8 a.m. shotgun start; 18 holes, cart and lunch; \$240 per team of four
- Sugar Creek Golf Course — Saturday, June 25 8 a.m. shotgun start; 18 holes, cart and lunch; \$240 per team
- Chippewa Golf Course — Saturday, July 16, 8 a.m. shotgun start; 18 holes, cart and lunch; \$240 per team
- Catawba Island Club — Sunday, Sept. 11, 1 p.m. shotgun start; 18 holes and cart; \$400 per team for golf; \$20 per person for dinner

Those teams who register for any two of the Oak Harbor, Sugar Creek or Chippewa golf events will be able to golf at the Sept. 11 Catawba Island Club event for free. Each golf event will include raffles, skins and other fun surprises for participating golfers.

“The United Way in Ottawa County Golf Experience is a great reason for golfers to visit some of our area’s great courses that they may have never played,” United Way in Ottawa County Area Director Chris Galvin said. “Each event takes place at a different local course for golfers to play while at the same time benefiting the United Way and the many county organizations it supports.”
